DIRECTIONS: On the I-14 north, exit Avenue K, drive approximately 2 miles, turn Left on Sierra Highway, it is on LHS about ½ mile.

Track/Schedule Information

Track opens at 7:00 AM. Registration and late tech are from 7:00 am closing @ 8:00 PM. THE MANDATORY **DRIVERS MEETING** is at **8:00 AM** Saturday & Sunday. Schedule will be provided at registration.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-14 North (Approx. 15 miles) exit Rosamond Road. Turn left (West) on Rosamond Road. Head approximately 5 miles until you see Willow Springs International Motorsports Park sign. (You'll see the track on your right before the sign.)

Track Services: The track has 100 Octane Unleaded & 110 Octane Leaded. Tire service is available. They also have RV hookups and Garage rentals. There is a café with sandwiches, drinks, burgers and such. For the people that hate portable restrooms there are "real" restrooms.

What do I need to do?????

- 1) Read the General Instructions. (Go to our website www.aroshpd.com for more info, Competition Code)
- 2) Fill out Entry Forms as appropriate.
- 3) If your car has not been classified contact classification person noted on website to get classified.
- 4) Send Entry Form(s) and Check (made out to AROSC) to the address noted before the deadline.
- 5) Prepare your car, and then have a Tech Inspection completed (**Before each event**) at one of the noted shops.
NOTE: A \$60 LATE Tech Inspection fee will be required if done at the track.
- 6) Arrive at the track early to allow enough time to unload and prepare your car.
- 7) **Bring the signed Tech inspection form** with you to registration at the track.
 - a. You will be assigned a run group and given a schedule and track map for the weekend.
- 8) **NOTE: We need to get started early. 2010 resolution...**
******Mandatory drivers meeting around 8:00 AM both Saturday & Sunday******
